Known or suspected Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease (CJD) patients treated at Cone Health

Before ordering any laboratory tests or performing any invasive procedure, the Infection Prevention Service and the Laboratory Medical Director or Pathologist-on-Call must be notified by phone or in person. Upon consultation with these practitioners, routine laboratory testing on specimens other than CSF or tissues may be performed as needed for the care of the patient.

Specimens such as CSF and body tissues carry an increased infectivity to health care workers. The collection and handling of these specimens require precautions at a level greater than the use of Standard Universal Precautions.

Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease (CJD) is a prior disease within the category of Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathy. Infection with CJD causes rapidly progressive dementia for which there is no treatment and leads to death within one year. Prions from CJD are resistant to usual sterilization procedures and can remain infective for years.
