<p>Technical Staff Update:</p>	<p>The average volume of RBC units collected in Adsol will change in Sunquest from 335 mls to 315 mls. The new volume will print on unit tags when Adsol RBC units are crossmatched to a patient. 315 mls will be the default volume for Adsol RBC units when techs enter single Adsol RBC units into inventory using Blood Product Entry or when performing Component Processing using an Adsol RBC unit. Also, Nursing's online Blood Administration procedure will be updated with the 315 mls volume the morning of July 24, 2018..</p>
