The new volume will print on unit tags when Adsol RBC units are crossmatched to a patient. 315 mls will be the default volume for Adsol RBC units when techs enter single Adsol RBC units into inventory using Blood Product Entry or when performing Component Processing using an Adsol RBC unit.
