<p>When:</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Tuesday, May 26, 2020</p>	
<p>What?</p>	<p>Currently BB test orders are restricted in SQ and do not display in collection devices until the orders are reviewed and accepted by BB staff. When BB orders are changed to unrestricted in SQ, the orders will immediately display in collection devices for phlebotomy staff and on pending worksheets for BB staff.</p>

<p>Why?</p>	<p>To prevent "missed" orders and to prevent delays in order receipt and collection. Reviewing all orders has become unmanageable due to increased test orders from WCC especially when BB staffing is minimal.</p>	
<p>What you will need to do to prepare:</p>	<p>BB staff - review the STOP announcement and revised procedure, "Order Entry from Nursing Divisions". Phlebotomy Staff: Learn BB test codes that do not require collection of a BB specimen. Contact BB when you have questions.</p>
