<p>Why?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The current testing method for GC/chlamydia (CT/NG) is suffering a testing supply shortage.</p>							
<p>What you will need to do to prepare:</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Understand there is NO CHANGE to L&D and other non-ED locations at ARMC. The current in-house method will remain in use for these locations. Understand URINE ONLY will be submitted from ED in a sterile urine cup with "do not open" stickers on the cup for the LabCorp reference lab test. Understand Mebane has collection device containers and will utilize those until the supply is exhausted.</p>

Alamance ED will change to the LabCorp send out test on **THURSDAY AUGUST 13 at 8am** for chlamydia/gonorrhea testing.

IT is working to make the order adjustment in CHL (working to remove the in-house test from ED order lists) and has confirmed this will be ready at 8am.

The LabCorp order being added is **LAB3386** which is
LCA test 183194 - Chlamydia/Gonococcus, NAA

Supply constraint:

LabCorp is short on collection supplies. LCA is having issues obtaining test collection devices from the vendor for both Urine and Swabs.

LCA does have an option where urine in a sterile container can be sent in for CT/NG. We can only accept URINE samples for CT/NG testing at this time.

Impact to the ARMC lab and ARMC ED:

The LCA test will be URINE ONLY.

Endocervical samples may not be collected. There are no available collection devices for this source at this time.

Urine will be sent in a sterile cup.

Reminder – this should be a “dirty catch” urine.
