- > Common names are ATS, ATM, Anaerobic transport system, Anaerobic transport media
- > Packaged in sterile pouch and used to maintain viability of microorganisms during specimen transport to Micro lab
- > Once the specimen is collected, the jar is opened and the specimen placed just below the surface of the agar
- > Close jar immediately
