

New Quantiferon TBSCP Collection, Processing and Bagging – Effective 11/12/18

- Collect one 6.0mL Lithium Heparin BD Vacutainer (Lawson # 142848) only one label will print
- Completely fill 6mL lithium heparin blood collection tube (5mL minimum required)
- Incubate sample at Room Temperature for at least 15 minutes but no longer than 3 hours
- After at least 15 minutes at room temperature, refrigerate the specimen within 3 hours of collection
- Transport the refrigerated sample to Shared Lab the same day (samples must be received within 24 hours)
- Place refrigerated specimens in GREEN Refrigerated Shared Lab Livermore bag for transport directly to Shared
- New test code TBSCP and tracking template code RVTBLV has been updated

To provide instructions for how to collect blood specimens for Quantiferon testing **PURPOSE** The following policy applies to collecting blood specimens for Quantiferon testing. **POLICY** · Refer to the Collecting Blood Specimens by Venipuncture SOP for steps to follow to collect blood specimens and the Identifying Outpatients for Specimen Collection SOP to identify patients for venipuncture. Specimens must be incubated at room temperature (17-25°C or 62.6-77°F) between 15 minutes and 3 hours after blood collection After 15 minutes at room temperature, refrigerate the specimen within 3 hours of collection and transport refrigerated to Shared Lab the same day Samples must be received at Shared Lab within 24 hours of collection **DO NOT** DO · Verify patient Draw from an inappropriate collection site identification · Leave the draw station unattended Introduce yourself to the patient and/or family · Draw blood without an order · Explain procedure to the patient and/or family · Attempt to collect blood when the patient and/or family refuse the Follow age specific procedure. (Refer to SOP Documenting Refused and Unsuccessful requirements Always label tubes Collections) Attempt more than 2 venipunctures times two phlebotomists before the patient · Recap Needles leaves Wash hands before and after the venipuncture

	 Collect at least 5.0 ml of blood by venipuncture directly into one 6.0 ml lithium heparin tube Keep the tube on the needle for 2-3 seconds once the tube appears to have completed filling to ensure the correct volume is drawn. If using a butterfly needle, a purge tube should be used to ensure the tubing is filled with blood prior to filling the 6.0 ml Lithium Heparin tube. 					to the indicator fill line, it is recommended to obtain another blood sample. Over or under filling the tubes will result in erroneous results and will lead to specimen rejection A minimum of 5 ml of blood is required
