Managing COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma Orders

Purpose Provide instruction for the management of COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma (CCP) orders.

Policy

- Plasma will be tagged by the blood supplier as investigational.
- · CCP has gained EUA (Emergency Use Authorization) product status, they are not FDA approved.
- Patients should receive no more than 2 transfusions of CCP. Each CCP unit is approximately 200 mL; verify transfusion history in SQ.
- CCP will only be ordered for patients that are hospitalized with a diagnosis of COVID.
- Notify patient provider if ABO incompatible plasma will be transfused due to inventory constraints. Document who
 was notified in a BBC in SunQuest.
- · Refer to "Plasma Compatibility Chart" for type selection.

Receiving a Convalescent Plasma

Enter plasma into SQ inventory system upon receipt of Convalescent Plasma.

- Unit will arrive with a tie tag designating it as a "Convalescent Plasma".
- The product code will designate it as a "Convalescent Plasma".
- · Whenever possible, segregated from other FFP inventory.

8	Provide a copy of the nursing job aid titled "Investigational COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma" with each unit issued to the floor if nursing requests administration support.
