## Procedure Change/Revision (IMM 36-A)

Procedure: Kappa and Lambda Free Light Chains (Binding Site) on the Siemens BNII Nephelometer (Doc# IMM 199)

Change/Revision: In the Interpretation of Results Section, Part A Reporting Results

1. The following change was made regarding retesting of New patients with abnormal results:

If the patient does not have any results in Test History, and the Kappa, Lambda or Kappa/Lambda Ratio is <u>out</u> of the normal range, repeat the testing at a 1:400 dilution.

- Go to Lab Journal
- Open the sample by double clicking on the Order#
- Click Dilution
- Click on 1:400, then OK
- Reload the sample on the BNII

If the 1:400 result is less than 5 times 1:100 result, report the 1:100

If the 1:400 result is greater than 5 times 1:100 result, report the 1:400.

2. K/L Ratios less than 0.01 will be reported as <0.01by SOFT. When the Kappa is less than the AMR and the ratio is <0.01, manually enter the ratio as <0.01.
