This small difference makes a big difference by preventing confirmation bias on the part of the staff member and precludes any opportunity for the patient to mishear the name spoken. 	All Staff

Missing the decimal point will cause the result to look 10x greater and likely cause the result to convert to >15.0. ** In fact, missing a decimal point could cause any result with < or > to convert to the upper or lower limits.
