

## **Umbilical Cord Samples**

- 1. Obstetrics team should notify the lab that an umbilical cord sample will be coming; a team member will run the sample to the lab.
- 2. Check the sample for a clot, follow all lab policies regarding clotted or QNS samples.
- 3. If sample is acceptable (meets laboratory policy on volume and clots), run immediately while the carrier waits.
- 4. All flagging on the sample should be ignored; the laboratory does not perform any interpretation of the results.
- 5. Give a copy of the results to the carrier.
- 6. The team may bring subsequent samples. Follow the same procedure.

\*Samples can be logged-in after running and should be logged in under the mother's medical record number with the appropriate order comment. Use the mnemonic "UCCBC" to log specimen into LIS\*
