PURPOSE

The following guidelines have been established to facilitate timely specimen order processing and quality patient care management.

SCOPE

This policy pertains to all Histology staff, IHC staff, residents, fellows and attendings.

Policy

The University of Washington Histology Laboratories Turnaround Guidelines demonstrates the established timelines for routine case work along with ordering cutoff and delivery timeline expectations for additional orders generated on cases.

Delays due to laboratory failures (i.e. equipment failures, staffing shortages, testing repeats, material not on site etc.) that will impact these timelines will be communicated by respective staff (Histo/IHC) to the faculty and residents.

Note: Requests for recuts and levels will be completed and sent out throughout the day as workload allows, thus some cases may arrive earlier. Emergent or special handling or routing needs are to be communicated to the respective labs (Histo/IHC).
