- 9. Regulatory Text: RETAIN EXISTING DOCUMENTS
- 10. Infant/Child Abduction: HMC no major changes, UWMC laminated door signs available and clarified checking doors for paperwork during drills.
- 11. Bioalert Plan: No major changes added Ebola plan into section.
- 12. Repetitive Stress Injury Prevention: No major changes
- 13. Specimen Transport: No major changes
- 14. Radioactive Specimen Plan: No major changes.
- 15. Suspicious Package Plan: No major changes
- 16. Appendix No major changes
