

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE: Patient Blood Bank History

<u>Purpose:</u> If a patient doesn't have a BBank History, a second sample must be collected at the time the BBand is placed to verify the patient's blood type. Lab will redraw the patient a second time by a different tech or phlebotomist to retype the ABO/Rh type of the patient before surgery.

Procedure:

- 1. Patient presents with Orders for Blood Bank tests.
- 2. Review patient BBank History in EHR to verify if a previous blood type is on file.
 - a. Go to Patient Product Inquiry Icon
 - b. Enter patient Medical Record number
 - i. Verify you have the correct patient
 - ii. Review the patient information banner at the top for the ABO/Rh type
 - iii. Review the Antibodies to see if patient has current antibodies
 - 1. If you see an entry under the antibodies column, draw extra pink and red top tubes to send to the Reference lab for identification.
- 3. If no patient history present, patient needs a second sample drawn for ABO/Rh retype
 - i. 2nd sample must be drawn by a different phlebotomist/tech
 - ii. Explain to the patient the need for a second sample no history
- 4. If you see the patient's ABO/Rh, draw patient per Blood Bank Specimen collection and BBand the patient if needed.
- 5. If you DO NOT see an ABO/Rh listed, RMC has no history on this patient.
 - a. First draw the patient per Blood Bank Specimen collection- and BBand the patient
 - b. Second, the patient must have a second sample drawn for the Retype.
 - i. 2nd sample must be drawn by a different phlebotomist/tech
 - ii. Explain to the patient the need for a second sample no history on file and we need 2 patient types verified before blood products can be given.
 - iii. Verify patient information before drawing the sample.
 - iv. Label properly for BBank.
- 6. Will not be able to login the ABO/Rh Retype sample until the T&S testing is completed.
- 7. Once ABO/Rh is completed, a Retype ABO/Rh sticker will automatically print with a new accession number
 - a. Login Retype sample with correct collection date/time/phleb
- 8. Techs will complete the Retype Testing per policy.
