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## Notes:

- 1. Use plain red tubes for discard.
- 2. Always ask the patient's primary caregiver before placing any IV on hold.
- 3. Keep IV "on hold" until all bloods are drawn.
- 4. Do not forget to release IVAC from 'hold' after blood draw is completed.
- 5. Documentation is essential. When an intravenous fluid is being administered in a patient's arm, blood should not be drawn from that arm if at all possible. The test results from this blood may be erroneous and thus misleading to the physician.
- 6. In some clinical situations, fluid from an IV line can still contaminate the specimen even after the IV was placed on hold. You may be asked to re-draw any specimen that yields questionable results.
