- Confidential patient information is anything that can identify a patient.

RCRA Waste

Example:

EPINEPHrine, Nitroglycerin, Warfarin, Inhalers with residual (empty in regular trash), barium, nicotine patches or gum, birth control pills with estrogen or estradiol, zinc oxide, silver nitrate sticks. meds in a container under pressure, chemo (only when chemo left in infusion bag, NOT

- Insulin
- Topical Gel with alcohol > 24%

TRACE in tubing)

Trace Chemo: Tier 1 HDs

All supplies used to make and administer chemo medication I.E: tubing, empty bags/bottles/vials, syringes, gloves, pads, masks, gowns, wipes,

etc.

Oral Chemo

Sharps are to be placed ONLY in 2 gallon Yellow Chemo sharps container.

Contact pharmacy to pick up all unused/unopened chemotherapy.
