## **Antimicrobial Subcommittee**

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### **POLICY:**

To assure that only antimicrobials that are consistent with the network pharmaceutical formulary and that are appropriate for the organism and body site are reported, the microbiology department in the Kettering Health Network participates in the network Antimicrobial Subcommittee meetings.

The microbiology department consults with the pharmacy and medical staff in developing the list of antimicrobial agents to be reported for specific organisms isolated from various body sites. These lists are based on CLSI recommendations.

These policies are reviewed annually with the stakeholders and records of these reviews are made available to the laboratory.

These same policies are to be used in reporting proficiency testing susceptibility results.

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
