



Temporary Procedure

Title: Liquid Plasma (type "A") and Reduced Oneg LPC Lifeline Storage

Samples Involved: None

Description:

Liquid Plasma (LP) will be used on Trauma patients with severe bleeding. LP is good for 26 days. Effective 10/10/18, the Blood Bank will supply 2 Oneg LPC and 2 type "A" LP to all Lifeline refrigerators: Indianapolis, Columbus, Richmond, Lafayette, and Terre Haute.

Blood Bank will:

1. Store type "A" Liquid Plasma @ MHBB. A special colored sticker will be applied on front of the bag upon receipt to differentiate it from Thawed Plasma (TP).
2. Supply all Lifeline refrigerators with 2 Oneg LPC and 2 type "A" LP.
 - a. There will be 4 extra units of type "A" LP available each week @ MHBB to replace transfused LP by Lifeline Crew.
 - b. Type "A" Thawed Plasma will be issued when type "A" LP is not available in stock. TP will be replaced 2 days prior to expiration date.
3. Refer to Emergency (Uncrossmatch) Blood Delivery and Transfusion Record SOP for documentation. Exceptions:
 - a. LP will have a separate Emergency (Uncrossmatch) Blood Delivery and Transfusion Record Form from the 2 Oneg LPC.
 - b. LP "Replace by" date range is when product is 15-20 days old.
4. Place on Quarantine shelf any returned LP from Lifeline.

Lifeline Replacement Schedule on 10/10/18: **Replace the 4 Oneg LPCs with 2 Oneg LPCs and 2 type "A" Liquid Plasma.**

NOTE: When LP is available @ MHBB on 10/10, prepare the 2 Oneg LPCs and 2 type "A" LPs ahead of time so we can switch out products easily when Lifeline crew arrives.

1. Indianapolis Lifeline will be replaced on Wednesday 10/10/18 on 2nd shift.
2. Richmond and Columbus lifeline will be replaced on Thursday 10/11/18 on Night Shift.
3. Lafayette and Terre Haute will be replaced on Thursday 10/11/18 on 1st or 2nd shift.
