Description:

Change the process for providing Ultrafresh/Fresh blood for certain cases:

- 1. Cardiovascular surgery: Issue Ultrafresh RBC first. If Ultrafresh is not available, then Fresh may be substituted without a phone call to the OR. This change has been preapproved by Dr. Turrentine if any nurse/physician has questions about this change, then let them know that Dr. Turrentine has approved this change with Dr. Le.
- 2. Neurosurgery: Issue Ultrafresh RBC first. If Ultrafresh is not available, then Fresh may be substituted without a phone call to the OR. This change has been preapproved by Dr. Ackerman if any nurse/physician has questions about this change, then let them know that Dr. Ackerman has approved this change with Dr. Le.
- 3. Washed unit inventory: The Washed unit for Neonatal Transfusions will now be selected from the Fresh unit inventory. Ultrafresh units are no longer required.
