#### Introduction


We are pleased to let you know that Release 4.4 of the CQUENCE Chain of Identity/Chain of Custody platform will be going live on September 29, 2024. This release brings several new enhancements and features that are highlighted below.

#### **Landing Page Updates**

The latest 2000 active records will now be displayed on the landing page. If the search criteria returned greater than 2000 results the portal user will need to refine their criteria to return fewer results. Due to this update the user will no longer be able to search by Patient Name in the search text box. If needed, please search by COI, Order ID, Order Journey Stage or Lot Number.


Filtering options will now automatically be visible on the landing page. After selecting filters and/or entering in a search criteria field, select the "Search" button to display the results. To remove your search results and load the originally displayed records select the "Clear Search" button.

For users that have access to the Upcoming Orders Report, we have now introduced a "Report" drop down button with the option to select "Upcoming Orders" or "Infectious Disease Marker Testing".



### **Collection Workflow Update**

The Apheresis Operator role or Apheresis Operator/Local Cell Lab Operator dual role will have a "Time Zone" dropdown for the End of Collection time. The "Time Zone" field will be prepopulated based on the operator settings in the CQUENCE Chain of Identity/Chain of Custody solution.



## <u>Autosave Functionality for Collection & Collection Shipment</u> <u>Workflows</u>

If an Apheresis or Local Cell Lab operator hasn't completed the Collection or Collection Shipment workflow and is logged out of the portal due to system inactivity, the data filled out will be automatically saved.

#### Update to the Infusion Workflow

Batch/Lot Number is now included in the Product Information Section.
