To ensure the proper functionality of eye wash stations through weekly quality assurance testing and document testing on log sheet and shower station are checked annually.	
SCOPE	
All areas / laboratories where eye washing stations are present.	
PROCEDURE	
<ol> <li>Emergency Eye Wash Station:         <ol> <li>Weekly, turn the station on and allow the water to flow out of the eyecups with sufficient flow to fully open the attached dust covers.</li> <li>Run the water for a minimum of 15 seconds.</li> <li>Shut off the water and place the dust covers over the eyecups.</li> </ol> </li> <li>On the eyewash log, write the date tested and initials.</li> <li>Emergency Shower Stations:         <ol></ol></li></ol>
