

Collection IDs for External Agencies 6Sep13

Audience: All MOL and RRL staff

What: New Collection IDs for external agencies in Department Order Entry and Specimen Log-In

Why: In an effort to capture volumes and gather metrics on external agencies, we need to ensure the appropriate external agency collection ID is being used.

How does this affect me? Effective immediately, enter the appropriate collection ID when ordering or receiving samples in Cerner. The following agencies have been built in Cerner:

Collection ID	Agency
VNA	Visiting Nurse Association
INTERIM	Interim HealthCare
DAVITA	DaVita (any location)
COMPLETE	Complete Home Health Care
OPTIMAL	Optimal Home Care
PPL FIRST	PeopleFirst Homecare

If one of these agencies drops off a sample, be sure to use the correct collection ID. If the agency is not listed above, use "NURSE" as the collector.
