

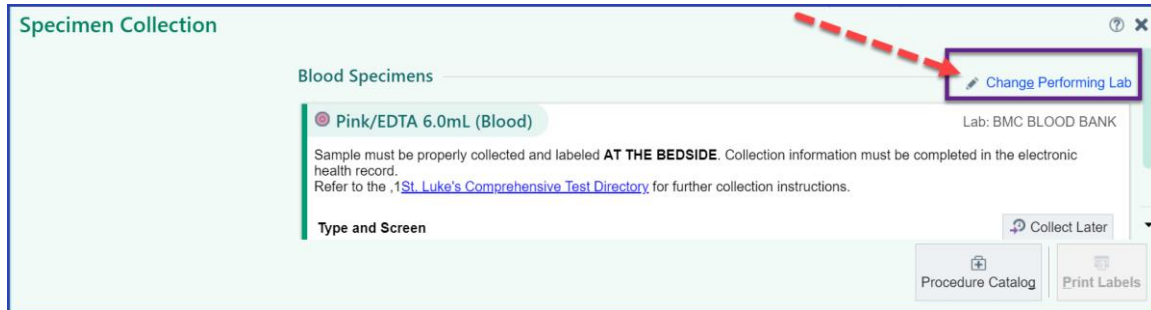
# Change Destination Lab for Pre-Procedural Transfusion Specimens

**Effective: already in production,** this document will assist on how to change the Destination Lab for a Pre-Procedural Transfusion specimens collected at a different location.

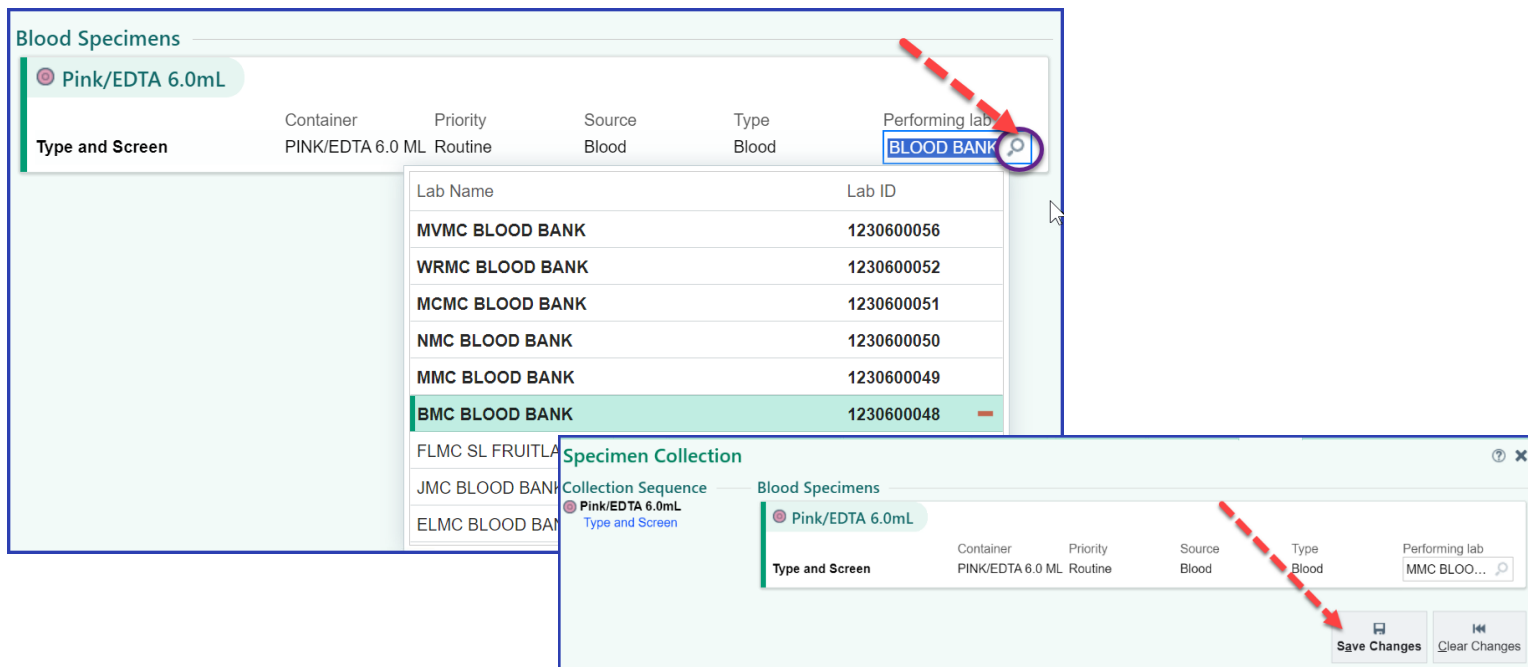
## How To Change Performing Lab

- From the Specimen Collection Screen
  - Click the blue hyperlink – **“Change Performing Lab.”**
    - Prior to Printing Labels!!**

**Note:** If the Performing Lab **Was Not Changed Prior to Printing Labels** – Need to Cancel and Reorder the Type and Screen.



- Click the magnifying glass – to choose the appropriate Performing Lab
  - Once the performing lab has been determined – Click the **“Save Changes”** button.



### 3. Complete the Collection Process:

- Print Labels, Complete the questions
- Mark the specimen as Collected.
