

I. PURPOSE:

To define requirements that must be met prior to putting a previously discontinued test back into production.

II. PROCEDURE:

A. When a test is put back into production, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. PT or alternative assessment must be performed within 30 days prior to restarting patient testing.
- 2. Method performance specifications must be verified, as applicable, within 30 days prior to restarting patient testing.
- 3. Competency must be assessed for analysts within 12 months prior to restarting patient testing.

Note: Appropriate departmental preproduction test validations and method performance specification verification procedures should be utilized when reactivating intermittent tests.

For tests for which PT is required by CAP, if a PT challenge is not offered during the 30-day period prior to restarting patient testing, the laboratory may perform an alternative assessment of the test. In such a case, the laboratory must participate in the next scheduled PT event.
